Corbet Lee Rasnake enlisted in the United States Army in 1939 and spent eleven years in service. He was discharged in May 1950. When he returned home, he married Esther Townsend. They had two children: Arthur Lee and Sandra Rasnake. Corbet was born July 5, 1920, the son of Arthur and Ethel Kiser Rasnake.
