Private Rasnake was inducted in 1943 and was killed in St. Lo, France, on August 5, 1944, at the age of 21 years. His parents were Arnold and Martha Rasnake of Route 1, Cleveland, Virginia. His brothers were Edward Rasnake of Route 1, Cleveland; Eugene Rasnake of Route 1, Lebanon and Arnold Rasnake, Jr. of Kingsport, Tennessee. His sisters were Rausie Rasnake Janesko (deceased) and Ruby Rasnake Richardson.
