Scott Brown Rasnake was inducted into the United State Army on September 10, 1943, at Roanoke, Virginia. He took his basic training at Hot Springs, Arkansas and Fort Sam Houston, Texas. He was discharged on May 16, 1946, with the rank of Private First Class. Scott was born on May 13, 1913, in Russell County, Virginia, the son of Arthur and Ethel Kiser Rasnake. He married Phoeba Counts and they had one daughter, Shirley.
